

THE BEHAVIOURAL CONTEXT OF ACCIDENT PREVENTION IN THE
WORKING AND LIVING ENVIRONMENT AND MANAGEMENT OF
EXTRAORDINARY SITUATIONS

Summary: Within the contemporary social context, which is more often and more dramatically characterized by extraordinary situations of various nature and character, the problems of people's safety, natural and material goods, and the related issues of management in such situations are constantly open, current and inspiring for researchers of different theoretical orientation and viewpoints. The achievement of safety objectives and tasks requires an adequate behavioural response, i.e. the behaviour both in the case of risk prevention in the working and living environment, and in the case of disasters. Starting with the consideration of problems of extraordinary situations within the context of sustainable development strategy, the paper presents a model for the prevention of accidents, calamities, and other extraordinary situations in the working and living environment.
