

ECONOMIC-SOCIAL DIMENSION OF HUMAN SECURITY DOCTRINE
UNDER THE CONDITIONS OF GLOBAL FINANCIAL AND ECONOMIC CRISIS

Summary: The paper analyzes the evolution of economic-social dimension of human security doctrine which has been the result of the pressure of global financial and economic crisis in the period from 2008 to 2012. The increase of unemployment to the scope which can be compared only with the one of the great economic crisis from 1929 to 1933, as well as the emergence of the class of precariats – workers deprived of their rights who find jobs in the parallel job market, are two phenomena which speak about the depth and complexity of world economic crisis disturbance. The attitudes on these phenomena of the most influential countries in the world gathered in Group 20 come face to face with the attitudes of the neo-Keynesian economists.
