Appendix-3

Brief Introduction of International Forum on Police Education Cooperation(IFPEC)

The People's Public Security University of China (PPSUC) has always been committed to building a bridge and platform for exchanges and cooperation between police education and training institutions worldwide, and making unremitting endeavors with our global partners to cultivate law enforcement talents who can adapt to international challenges and build a universally safe community with a shared future for mankind.

With the strong support of the partner college and universities of PPSUC and after three years of preparation, the International Forum on Police Education Cooperation (IFPEC) was formally established at PPSUC in Beijing, China on November 12th, 2019. PPSUC was selected as the first chairman of the forum and the permanent secretariat.

IFPEC is a non-profit and open exchanges and cooperation alliance, which is voluntarily composed by the police institutes in countries and regions along the "Belt and Road" in accordance with the principle of "equality, cooperation, mutual assistance and mutual benefit". The purpose of the IFPEC is to maximize the exchanges and cooperation between member institutes by sharing best practices and research in the field of police education and training, as well as to jointly discuss and establish an international standard for police education and training, capacity building of teaching staff, scientific research, and improvement of curriculum, and enhance cultural mutual trust and mutual understanding among countries and regions.

In September 2021, based on the consensus reached among the member institutions and the Action Plan, PPSUC will take the opportunity of holding the annual "12th International Policing Forum" to hold the Sub-forums for Police Academy Leaders and Young Police Cadets/Officers on "Changes and trends of police education in response to the pandemic control".
